There are a tremendous number of incidents of violence throughout our country (please see statistics) and this violence must stop. We can confront violence on the street and in our homes if we work together. Violence is not our number one problem our number one problem is we do not have a general consensus as what we should do about violence in our country. All of us need to work together to rid our nation of violence making our streets safe again. The first decision all of us need to make is that we are all going to get involve and do whatever we can do in any capacity to end violence in our nation. Ending violence begins with everyone. It begins with our changing and making up our minds that we are going to confront this issues with all of our resources until we see a drastic change in the statistics being reported on the number of murders and rapes being committed in this country and the number of juveniles crimes being committed in this country.

The Institute researched the murders of 20,000 women, murders that occurred across this country from 1930 to 2003, a 70-year period. This is what we learned when we looked at the victim and this is what we learned when we looked at the assailant. When we looked at the victim we learned. Women are being murdered because they do not know they are in danger. Many women live their lives wearing blinders. Lives could be saved if women are told danger signs and warnings. Murder is not a spontaneous combustion. We also learned women talk too much and they make too many assumptions and that is why men are able to murder them. Women invite murderers into their lives and into their homes. These are not flattering characteristics but nevertheless true of many women. Understanding these facts can lead to the solutions of some murders and the prevention of others. The key lies in why women talk so much and how they make assumptions. We designed The Women's Art Exhibit to deal with this phenomenon to make women aware of their behavior. We want women to know if they change the way they think they can reduce the possibilities that they will become a victim thus saving their life and the live of their children. When we looked at the assailant it was the assailant's profile that led us to the idea that we need to seek God. What we learned looking at the assailants over the same 70 year period was over 252,287 women have been murdered in this country; 25 million children in this country were born to single women and 2.5 million men have been imprisoned prison with over 4000 people on death row over this same period. When we look at these figures again and again we saw it. Education and economics were factors in imprisonment but not the essential element. The essential element was fathers. The absence of true fathers in the home has devastated our nation. Please note we did not say the absence of men in the home or the absence of males in the home we said the absence of fathers in the home. A closer look at the assailant led us to ask the question what is supporting this activity what is supporting the violence we are seeing. The answer is evilness. Evilness was supporting the violence we were seeing. The evilness was regenerative in nature. And the only weapon against evilness is God. It is evilness that has run men from the home and the only way to fight evilness is to seek God. There is only one way to stop violence and that is by using the word of God to change the behavior of men and women. Please see Job 1:6-7 and Job 2: 1-2 and 1 Peter 5:5. We can support this statement but not here (see The Wall). Preventing violence is the Institute's number one priority. But when we examined our data we realized the only way our goal could be accomplished was if we began to lead for social changes.

We developed the following handouts* to be distributed throughout the country to give men and women pause as they go about their daily lives. Hopefully the handouts will cause you to think how your conduct will affect your wife, children and extended family. No one behaves in a vacuum. Sooner or later what we do in the dark will come to the light so it shall be for adultery and fornication. If you look at the various incidents of violence reported in the newspapers, you can clearly see that there is evilness associated with these acts. Every time a person is murdered that death leaves hundreds of people with unresolved emotion and pain. Murder leaves children motherless thus susceptible to abuse because their primary caregiver and protector is gone regenerating the violence cycle. Murder, rape, robbery and acts of incest are the main ingredients of the violence cycle causing these acts to be regenerated in man for generation after generation after generation. The only way to stop regenerative evilness is to use the word of God, which is what we are attempting to do here. We must to break these patterns of evilness is we are to survive as a people. Murder and rape does not have to be acceptable behaviors in society yet today we hear only news blips that people are fed up with this type of behavior. We must once and for all decide we are going to change and once we make this decision we must fight to remain forever changed working for the good of man. * The handouts are two sided.

He's happier when he is with me. It is not my fault she stopped growing. She must know she is in the way. If she wants to make him happy she should let him go. She'll never make him as happy as I do.

Something as wonderful as this could not be wrong. It just happened. I know what I am doing. Everything will be all right if she will just leave him. He doesn't want her anymore. He wants me. I make him happy. We are good together. He told me so. I'm a good person. Things would be perfect if she would just leave. She must know it is over. Why is she hanging on? She doesn't want him, if she did she would fight for him. She doesn't love him the way I do. She doesn't love his body the way I do. She doesn't treat him the way I treat him. I am the woman who makes him happy. Everything would be perfect if she just would leave him. Everything would be perfect if she just would get out of the way. I would not be with him like this

if she would just give him a divorce. Why is she hanging on? Their marriage is over, finished. He told me he told her so.

Hi Elaine I am glad you called, yes he will be here soon I knew you would call just to see what happened. Girl he called me again last night! I can't get him to go home. She has to know he is not bowling. The bowling alley closes at 10 o'clock and he didn't leave me until 2:00 a.m. The other night I made certain he did not go home at all. It is time for her to know. She had her chance and she blew it. How can a woman not know her husband is fooling around, if he stays out late at night? She knows he doesn't want her anymore. It is not my problem he wants me more than he wants her. Women are always clinging to a man who doesn't want them. She knows she is in the way. He was ready for a new and better relationship when I showed up. If she was doing what she was supposed to do at home he would not need me. It is not my problem she can't keep her man. She should put him on a leash ha, ha.

I am not responsible for his wife. She had her chance. If he is out looking I might as well answer his ad because he is going to find someone anyway and it might as well be me. Can you imagine how good it is going to be once she realizes she is in the way?

I laughed all during that time, she was no better than me. Can you imagine she is at work and I'm in her bed. When I left her house I put my lipstick on her dresser. One night I called and called. There is No Exceptions To God's Law

.....Some of you are the sons of prostitutes and you know not your father. Don't worry; God pushes the prostitute aside. He holds the father in contempt. Remember Midian sinned and his sons were punished because Midian taught his sons to live a profane life. Ahab sinned and his sons were punished because Ahab taught his sons to live a profane life. Men from all over the world are bringing women into this country to be sold for sex. They are able to bring these women into this country because many of our leaders allow this practice. Our leaders smile and say there is money to be made. God is not going to continue to tolerate this hypocrisy. You have a man sitting as a judge of men, calling the men who come into his courtroom the scum of the earth, then right after court the judge runs to meet his mistress or feast on the nearest prostitute. The judge smiles to himself and thinks no one knows. The judges have forgotten God's words. He has forgotten that God said thou shall not commit adultery.

There is also the man who goes to church every Sunday and sits with his wife. He tells everyone he holds the prostitute in disdain. Yet he is the biggest consumer of the women working in the sex trade in this country. He just thinks he is hiding his behavior from everyone. All of the 25 million fatherless children were conceived after an act of fornication. Many of you in prison today are one of the 25 million fatherless children in this country. Do not grieve God knows the absence of a nurturing father was a factor that led you to crime.

If the father is not present in the home, the family may or may not develop properly. A woman can teach her son to be a human being, but she cannot teach him to be a man. Remember the shade loving plant and the sun loving plants. Comfort yourself and forgive yourself for God has forgiven you.

Advise to the Young, Proverbs 1: 8 My child, pay attention to what your father and mother tell you. Their teaching will improve your character.....My child, when sinners tempt you, don't give in. Suppose they say, "Come on; let's find someone to kill! Let's attack some innocent people for the fun of it. Robbery always claims the life of the robber - this is what happens to anyone who lives in violence.

Note: There is not a month that goes by that a man is not sentenced to life in prison without parole in the City of Detroit some of these men are the sons you left behind. Sons you did not believe worthy enough for you to work for or to spent your leisure time.

Hands Across America

When it comes to sex, society says that the woman is the responsible party, not the man. And in many situations, the man is also absolved of parental responsibility. Engage a woman in a conversation about rape, and watch her reaction. She will inevitably attack the woman, not the man. Somewhere in the back of the woman's mind, she also feels that the female was the underlying cause of the rape, except with incest or in situations involving children. Even though she is repulsed by the idea of rape, somewhere in the back of her mind she feels that the woman could have done something to stop the rape.....

.....Women still believe that rape is an act of passion. The man has to have it. Many women believe that men cannot be fully responsible for their lack of self-control. Women believe that the underlying facet of rape is lust, lust in the romantic sense. Lust is a function of rape, but not in the romantic sense; it is lust when it is defined as lasciviousness. Lust is an uncontrolled or illicit sexual desire or appetite. It is the desire to reproduce the same emotional experience that can be imagined or realized. Rape has nothing to do with sex or sexual desires as they are normally portrayed romantically in books. Rape is not an act of passion; it is an act of rage. Rape is an act in which power is used to produce degradation and humiliation. Rape is an act used to render a woman powerless and to destroy her.

Rape has nothing to do with romance. Romance has never been a function of rape. Rape is second to murder as being the basest of sins. Never mistake rape for romance. Rape has also become a sport. Rape has become the recreation of men. Many men believe rape is funny. Women are now hunted and preyed upon. Women are prizes to be won. Some males see getting a woman into bed as a conquest. Also, the act of murder is no longer repulsive; it is an act which many males merely consider how to accomplish successfully to avoid prosecution. Rapists and murderers are willing to take the risk on the chance that they may succeed.

As an undershepherd, you have undoubtedly been faced with the challenge of reaching out to a lost sheep. The National Institute of the Study of Violence (NISV) also seeks to restore lost sheep. The NISV is a non-sectarian organization dedicated to breaking the cycle of domestic and sexual violence through advocacy, education, and related support services.

We are currently distributing copies of The Wall, an abuse intervention book aimed at men imprisoned for acts of domestic violence. We have begun distributions to prisoners held in the Ryan and Mound and Scott facilities. Our goal is to get copies to incarcerated men and women throughout the Michigan penal system by December 2005.

The Wall was written in response to the numerous repeat domestic violence offenders who expressed a need for help in breaking the self-destructive behaviors that have marred their lives. The Wall is designed to help men recognize mental strongholds and patterns of behavior that cause them to lash out in violence. It also offers alternative solutions for managing many of the life difficulties that prevent men from fulfilling their full potential. These men are the fathers, sons, and brothers needed in our homes. We hope to restore men, restore families, and heal the wounds caused by domestic violence.

We need your help. We are asking churches, civic groups, and all who care to purchase a book for a prisoner. We believe a prisoner should be given intensive training while in prison so that once paroled, he has confidence for the future, not fear.

Preventing violence is the Institute's number one priority. To accomplish our goal we will lead for social change. There is only one way to stop violence and that is by using the word of God to change the behavior of men and women.

The Institute has published The Wall, Hands Across America and four volumes of the series Do This In Remembrance of Me to make violence relevant to every man and woman living in this country. Our goal now is to present information to the American public that cannot be ignored. The Wall was written telling men that they can change their lives if they change the way they think. Hands Across America was written to alert women to the dangers around them and to get them to be cognizance of the behavior of some men. The Institute has developed five goals to tackle violence in the country and they are:

To get men and women to consider changing their lives by changing the way they think and to live their lives with standards and integrity and to consider the benefits of marriage.

To stop the number of women between the ages of 40 - 50 from being the fastest growing number of new Aids victims in the country: Loneliness and lack of companionship is causing this phenomenon.

To reduce the number of children born in one-parent families by decreasing fornication and increasing the number of marriages in the country: The more marriages we have the fewer children will be in foster care. Many children in our foster care system and fatherless homes become inmates in our prisons because they do not have a male present in the home functioning as a father. The absence of true fathers in the home has devastated our nation. Fathers are the stabilizing element of a family when in turmoil. A father is the solidifying force that children go to for resolution or resolve.

To reduce the number of people committing adultery: Adultery destabilizes the family and brings violence into the home

To stop non-related males from living in home with children: Many of these males are transients with no goals or purpose to their lives and some are drug users that end up violating children in their beds. Children are being stabbed, bitten, raped, kicked, scalded, strangled and murdered in their homes. This has to stop. These men do not belong in a home with children. They have lived in violent situations and they bring violence into the home. They have no patience or training to be caregivers.

The drawings were done with integrity and tastefulness. The exhibit is designed to prevent violence against women by giving women extensive information that may save their lives. The full exhibit will be introduced October 2007 (The National Domestic Violence Month) in Michigan. Between now and September 2007, the Institute will be touring Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Ohio, and Wisconsin publicizing the exhibit. We will show the mini-exhibit at churches, conventions, large corporations, state office buildings, and universities.

Violence against women is taking an enormous emotional and financial toll on this country. Part of the drug world consists of individuals self-medicating themselves, trying to forget the violence they have experienced as children, trying to forget the moments of rape, humiliation, and degradation that they experienced. We need to prevent children from going hungry, feeling displaced, neglected and abandoned. We believe these factors contribute to the fear and rage that develop in children causing them to become violent in adulthood. Women and children cannot develop and grow into a family unit if their environment is filled with violence.

The Institute believes that we can reduce the violence experienced by women and children if female organizations and like minded organizations work together. The prevention of violence directly affects the stability of the nation. Violence against women is an unpleasant subject, but we, as a nation must face this phenomenon if we are to survive as a people.
